

Resident Garden

Garden beds are available for use by residents of the Parkrose Apartments.

Each bed is assigned to one or more residents, who will be responsible for maintenance and adherence to the following Rules of Use.

Rules of Use:

1. Garden beds will be maintained in a tidy state.
 - a. Gardening tools and supplies must be stored out of sight.
 - b. Dead plants and pests should be addressed immediately.
 - c. Plants should not be allowed to grow past the edges of the beds such that they interfere with other gardens or movement around the patio.
2. Garden space is a shared resource. The resident(s) assigned to a given bed should allot space in a fair manner such that all interested residents have an opportunity to participate.
3. Garden beds will be maintained at the resident's own expense and risk. The landlord is not responsible for maintenance costs of resident gardens and is not liable for any damage or loss of plants, tools, or gardening supplies due to any cause.
4. Cannabis or any plant which may produce a controlled substance is not permitted.
5. Chemical pesticides and products which are harmful to animals and other plants should be avoided.
6. Garden beds are for residents only. Prior to moving out, any bed assigned to a departing resident must be cleared or transferred to another resident.
7. Garden beds may be reassigned and permission to use the beds may be withdrawn for any reason, including failure to adhere to these Rules of Use.
